1. OVERALL AIM OF THE SERVICE

This may include engaging with Cluster Practices and other stakeholder professionals and organisations in their completion of this work and compiling the overall results, business case development or other stakeholder meetings.
- To actively engage and encourage involvement of, with and consultation of patients in Cluster ideas and project work.
