Programme Update

- Welsh Government have funded 2 data analysts at NHSBSA to support the Wales GDS Reform Programme and produce monitoring reports. Advice and support provided.
- Engagement event held for all HBs (including DPAs) on 20 June 2019. WG and Health Education Improvement Wales (HEIW) also provided their input.
- PHW 1000 lives and Dr Natalie Joseph-Williams (Cardiff University) are supporting HEIW to develop a Shared Decision Making CPD course for dental teams.
- Contract for the qualitative evaluation of the programme has been awarded to Bangor University. The evaluation will be led by Professor Paul Brocklehurst.
- HEIW QI Educators will work with dental teams and HBs to set up Local Quality Improvement Groups in each HB.
- MPWiP has been offered to all GDS reform practices across Wales.

Activities for the Next Reporting Period

- Review and update ACORN and update ACORN guidance document
- Analyse data from NHS BSA for annual programme report
- Work to begin on reviewing current dental legislation and identifying changes to support the GDS Reform Programme
- Work with HBs to encourage more practices to join the programme
- Work with HBs and DPAs to ensure correct interpretation of the new monitoring reports from the NHS BSA
- Programme team will also utilise HEIW website and portal to share information on the GDS reform programme.
- Work with HBs in supporting practices to move to stage 2. We hope more practices will move to stage 2 in October 2019.
