## **NEWS**

**Mental Health and Wellbeing:** First round of presentations arranged to present the draft national report to Directors of Primary & Community Care, National Primary Care Board, Vice Chairs and Mental Health Network Board – look out for virtual engagement events being planned across Wales over the summer period to share this work.

**Cluster Peer Review:** ACD transition year peer review process was supported by the Strategic Programme Board. The peer review is a component of the broader <u>monitoring end evaluation framework for the Primary Care Model for Wales.</u> 2022/23 will be the pilot year for the peer review to test the methodology. **Professor Ceri Phillips** has been confirmed as Chair of the peer review panel. Work is progressing to develop a briefing pack for the pilot sites – more information to follow.

All Wales Diabetes Prevention Programme (AWDPP) Work continues across Wales on the implementation of the AWDPP across 14 Wave 1 clusters (92 GMS practices) and to include some clusters who are utilising SPPC funding and other funding sources. The programme was <u>launched</u> to coincide with Diabetes UK 'Diabetes Awareness' week during the week of 13<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> June, which included a visit by the Deputy Minister to Swansea Bay health board to hear from patients and professionals about the Programme. As part of the launch, the AWDPP Intervention Protocol was also published

### **KEY MILESTONES**

Work in the SPPC has progressed and remains on track to deliver agreed products. Key deliverables this quarter include:

<u>Accelerated Cluster development</u> online toolkit was launched, providing information and resources for stakeholders to support the implementation of the ACD programme during the 2022/23 transition year. Included in this toolkit are two illustrations a <u>roadmap</u> and an overview 'plan on a page' to explain the totality of ACD.

<u>Cluster Planning Support Portal</u> (CPSP) launched – online resource to support the development of Cluster/Pan Cluster Planning group's annual plans.

The **Community Infrastructure** work is progressing at pace and the key stakeholder group has been established and first meetings held, also set up are the support task and finish groups for:

- Care Home Immunisation Model
- Community Nursing Vision Framework
- Multi Profession and Virtual Ward
