ACCELERATED CLUSTER DEVELOPMENT (ACD): WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The Accelerated Cluster Development Programme is the Primary Care component of Place Based Care, delivered through Professional Collaboratives and Clusters. Collaboratives bring together General Medical, Dental and Optometric Practitioners, Pharmacists, Nurses, Allied Health Professionals (AHPs) and Social Care professionals, within their professional groups, to assess population needs and service improvement priorities. Solutions are developed within Collaboratives and through multi-disciplinary Cluster working.
