QI project guidance for 2024-25

This letter follows on from the information provided to practices on 30 April 2024, providing further information on Quality Improvement projects for 2024-25.

In April, we noted that 2024-25 Quality Improvement (QI) project cycle would consist of two projects, with the allocation of points as set out below:

Supporting Healthy Behaviours project (continuation of 2023-24 Unhealthy Behaviours project)	100 points
Prescribing Safety project	70 points
Total	170 points

This year's QI cycle will run until 31 March 2025 and completion of both projects is mandatory for practices participating in the QI process.

Project specifications are enclosed with this letter, providing an overview of the objectives and requirements to demonstrate achievement. These specifications will enable practices to undertake QI activity. A reporting template is being developed and will be circulated to practices by end of October 2024.

Practices will be aware that Audit+ will no longer be available after December 2024. As noted in the project specifications, Digital Health and Care Wales will provide support to practices to ensure that QI activity for 2024-25 can continue after this date.


